Requirements - Projects are only eligible for judging if they meet the following guidelines: Projects that involve tissues, human subjects (in any capacity), hazardous materials, and/or bacteria **MUST** submit paperwork and be approved by **NOVEMBER 11, 2019**. Projects must have a testable hypothesis or an engineering design. *Scientific demonstrations without a testable hypothesis will not be judged.*

Students Grades 6-12: Student projects will be judged only if the requirements above are met. Awards will be given to those students who advance to the LA County Science & Engineering Fair. Students must be present with project for the duration of judging.

Students Grades K-5: Student projects will be displayed in the Exhibition Room. Students showing projects in the Exhibition Room must be present at the event and one student must be with the project at all times.

Students are responsible for set up and removal of their own projects.
